



2016 TREE PURCHASE REBATE

The City of Maplewood is offering a purchase rebate to residential and commercial property owners for planting deciduous shade trees on landscaped property in Maplewood. The Tree Purchase Rebate encourages planting mostly native shade trees on private property. It helps property owners replace trees lost to Dutch elm disease, oak wilt and emerald ash borer.

The purchase price of a shade tree will be reimbursed by the City at a cost-share of 50%--up to \$100 per tree. Each household or business may purchase up to 4 trees, for a maximum reimbursement of \$200 per year. First, the tree is purchased and planted. Then the purchase receipt and the Tree Purchase Rebate Form are submitted for reimbursement.

The following requirements must be met to qualify for the rebate:

1. Reimbursement will be made only for trees listed on the Replacement Species List (see next page).
2. Trees may be purchased from any nursery.
3. Any size tree may be planted.
4. Cost must be reasonable for size of tree.
5. Only the cost of the tree will be reimbursed (not delivery or installation).
6. **Receipt must be submitted indicating amount paid for tree, species of tree and size of tree.**
7. Trees must be planted on private property in Maplewood.
8. Tree must be installed in a landscaped area, such as a yard. Trees planted in woodlots will not be reimbursed. Trees may not be planted on boulevards or other types of right-of-way.
9. Tree Purchase Rebate Forms are processed twice a year; forms are due July 15 or October 15.
10. Rebates are given at the discretion of the program manager and as long as dedicated funds allow.
11. City staff will verify the tree has been appropriately planted before reimbursement is made.

Before planting, call GOPHER STATE ONE CALL (651-454-0002) to have utilities located. It's the law.

To Apply for Rebate

1. Fill in form below. Cut at dotted line.
2. Attach a copy of the receipt for tree purchase. Receipt should indicate tree species.

Qualifying Replacement Tree Species List

Note on Tree Names and Identification:

Ask the nursery for a written verification of the tree species with the common and scientific names listed. Scientific names consist of two words – Genus, and species.

ex: Red Maple (common name), *Acer rubrum* (Genus & species).

If the tree is a cultivar of a native species, a name in single quotes will follow the genus and species.

ex: *Ulmus americana* 'Valley Forge' (resistant cultivar of American Elm)

These recommended species, including these varieties and cultivars, qualify for the City of Maplewood's 2016 Tree Purchase Rebate (**See exceptions as noted below**):

- Apple (*Malus* spp.), (**No crabapple**)
- Aspen: Large-Toothed (*Populus grandidentata*)
- Quaking (*Populus tremuloides*)
- Basswood or American Linden (*Tilia americana*)
- Birch: Paper (*Betula papyrifera*),
- River (*Betula nigra*)
- Black Cherry (*Prunus serotina*)
- Black Walnut (*Juglans nigra*)
- Blue Beech (*Carpinus caroliniana*)
- Butternut (*Juglans cinerea*)
- American Elm (*Ulmus americana* 'Valley Forge' or 'Cathedral')
- This native hybrid tested as most resistant to Dutch elm disease.
- Hackberry (*Celtis occidentalis*)
- Hawthorn or Thornapple (*Crataegus* spp.)
- Hickory: Bitternut (*Carya cordiformis*)
- Shagbark (*Carya ovata*)
- Ironwood (*Ostrya virginiana*)
- Kentucky Coffeetree (*Gymnocladus dioica*)
- Mountain Ash (*Sorbus americana*)
- Oaks: Bur Oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*)
- Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*),
- Swamp White Oak (*Quercus bicolor*)
- White Oak (*Quercus alba*)
- Northern Pin Oak (*Quercus ellipsoidalis*)
- Pagoda Dogwood (*Cornus alternifolia*)
- Serviceberry or Juneberry
- Allegheny Serviceberry (*Amelanchier laevis*)
- Downy Serviceberry (*Amelanchier arborea*)
