- Show respect during comments and/or discussions, listen actively and do not interrupt or talk amongst each other.
- Be respectful of the process, keeping order and decorum. Do not be critical of Commission members, staff or others in public.
- Be respectful of each other's time keeping remarks brief, to the point and non-repetitive.
